Title: Children's Ministry Leadership Team

Job Description: Coordinates with Children's Director to set policies, evaluate programs, establish procedures, and recruit volunteers. Prays regularly for children, families, and ministry.

Rotation Schedule: Monthly meeting

Title: Lead Teacher

Job Description: Teaches Sunday School. Coordinates small group activities, games and crafts with other helpers. Develops relationships with children and parents so parents are comfortable and kids know they matter. Pre-K, Elementary, and Pre-teen opportunities. Quarterly training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: Worship Leader

Job Description: Leads worship during Sunday School with excitement, passion, and extravagant motions. Elementary opportunities. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: Adult Helper

Job Description: Helps the Lead Teacher with Sunday School crafts, games, and small group activities. Creatively helps children keep focused during teaching and activity time. Develops relationships with children and parents so parents are comfortable and kids know they matter. Pre-K, Elementary and Pre-teen opportunities. Quarterly training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: Youth Helper

Job Description: Helps the Lead Teacher with Sunday School crafts, games, and small group activities. Creatively helps children keep focused during teaching and activity time. Develops relationships with children so kids know they matter. Shows children how to welcome visitors, be a good sport during games, be kinds to others, and be helpful in all things. Pre-K, Elementary, and Pre-teen opportunities. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: A/V Tech

Job Description: Operates the audiovisual equipment during Sunday School. Develops relationships with children so kids know they matter. Elementary opportunities. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: Check-In Greeter

Job Description: As parents bring children to Sunday School, records children's names, gives name cards to parents, and helps keep children in their designated areas once they're signed in. Develops relationships with parents and children so parents are comfortable and kids know they matter. Elementary opportunities. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: A one month commitment to one service (early or late) with two months off.

Title: Nursery Helper

Job Description: Provide safe and nurturing care for babies and toddlers during church services and other church activities. Develop relationship with parents and children so that the babies are comfortable and parents can walk away without undue distraction. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: One Service, One Sunday per month.

Title: Youth Babysitters

Job Description: Provide attentive and high quality care for a wide range of children during church activities. Develop relationship with children so kids know they matter. Sometimes paid. Semi-annual training and support meetings.

Rotation Schedule: As needed, usually for two to four hours at a time.
